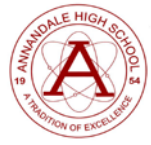

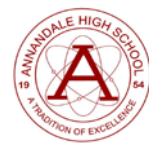

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- A student can only receive credit for one letter during a season. For example, if they played on the JV for part of the basketball season, but also played enough varsity quarters to earn a varsity letter, they only get points for the varsity letter.
- If a student is suspended during his/her sport for any reason, during their senior year, the student cannot qualify for the scholarship.
- An individual's social media activity may be considered.
- The tie breaker is the most Total Athletic Points.
